Strengths

- Circular profile eliminates corners, areas known for clotting and stasis
- Reduced velocity changes at the inlet, where blood stasis can occur
- System with compact dimensions and simple, intuitive user interface
- FDA-approved in 2020, also CE-approved

Weaknesses

- No own blood pump, but depends on component-based blood pumps
- Distribution of products available only through Medtronic



- Main focus: commercializing innovative heart and lung devices
- Founded in 1991 as a spin-off from the University of Michigan
- In 2013, MC3 was acquired and turned into a commercial ECMO-focused company
